2023 - CULTIVATING SUCCESS

This year's Cross Pollinate is called Cultivating Success. Over the course of two days we will be tackling a subject that's as thorny as blackberry – making small-farms work financially!

It's a big one, but we're facing it head on with a fun, fast-paced, thought-provoking, and outcomes-focused event.

Day 1 – Moonah Arts Centre, Sunday June 25th

Day 1 is the main event. We have an amazing line up of speakers from farming and non-farming backgrounds who will give a series of short talks. These will look at the pros and cons of growth, how local food systems join the dots for small farming businesses, how making space can increase productivity, and how to do more to do less.

These will be interspersed by a 'Dare to Ask' panel discussion with four well known Tasmanian farmers, recorded conversations with two leading Australian small-scale regenerative farmers, facilitated sessions, and short films.



Day 2 – Farm tours in the Coal River Valley, Southern Tasmania

Day 2 will be a bus tour of small-scale farms in the Coal River Valley, where we visit farms that all have a story to tell when it comes to staying financially viable.

The day will end with drinks, nibbles and chance to catch up with friends old and new
